Scholarships

The Jefferson City Parks and Recreation Commission ensures no youth is excluded from its programs due to financial barriers. Recreation scholarships, funded by the Parks and Recreation Foundation, are available through a simple application process. Eligibility typically requires public assistance benefits, with annual funding capped at \$200 per individual for JC Parks-run programs. Short-term, non-staff-led programs like clinics are excluded. Applications must be signed by a parent/guardian, and participants must contribute at least 20% of program fees.





LIABILITY

JC Parks and/or the Jefferson City Parks and Recreation Commission does not provide insurance coverage for injuries suffered while participating in programs or using facilities. Any costs related to such injuries should be presented to your personal medical insurance carrier.

Refund Policies

Program cancelations may be made Mon - Fri, 8am-5pm, by calling (573) 634-6482 or in person at 1299 Lafayette Street. The Parks and Recreation Commission has adopted the following refund policy regarding programs and facilities:

PROGRAMS

- 1. If a cancelation is made prior to the registration deadline, a refund will be given, less a processing fee: \$10 for program fees up to \$99; \$20 for program fees \$100 & over.
- 2. If a cancelation is made after the registration deadline, a credit for future programs/reservations will be given for 1/2 of the fee paid. Once a program starts, no refund/credit will be given unless a medical statement substantiates the injury or illness.
- 3. Fees paid for team registrations are not refundable once a team registration has been accepted and recorded except as in #6 below.
- No credits, refunds, or make-up classes will be issued for programs missed due to personal reasons.
- 5. A refund or credit will be granted when medical illnesses/injuries are substantiated by a medical note.
- 6. Full refunds are made if a program is canceled by JC Parks.

CAMPS

- 1. A \$25 processing fee will be charged per week, per child for every refund issued.
- 2. All camp refunds must be requested two weeks prior to the first day of the program.
- 3. If a cancelation is made after the registration deadline, a refund will be given for 1/2 of the fee paid.
- 4. Once a program starts, no refund will be given unless a medical statement substantiates the injury/illness.
- Camp transfers need to be approved by the Program Manager, Angie Toebben. Send requests to atoebben@jeffersoncitymo.gov

FACILITIES/HAYRIDES

- 1. Fees paid for admission to park facilities are not refundable.
- 2. The holding fee required to reserve park facilities/shelters is not refundable under any circumstance except as in #5 below.
- 3. If a cancelation occurs ten or more business days prior to the scheduled reservation, the facility/hayride rental fee and deposit is refundable, less a \$10 processing fee.
- If a cancelation occurs less than ten business days prior to the reservation, 1/2 of the rental fee and the entire damage deposit will be refunded.
- 5. Full refunds are made if a rental is canceled by JC Parks.

POOL RENTALS

- 1. Weather cancelations are at the discretion of JC Parks Aquatics staff.
- 2. Reservation fees for pools are not refundable under any circumstance except as in #4 below.
- 3. Transfer of rental date must be requested two weeks prior to reservation date.
- 4. Full refunds are made if a rental is canceled by JC Parks.

AMUSEMENT PARK TICKETS

All amusement park ticket sales are final. Refunds are not issued for amusement park tickets.

Late Fees

Many parks and recreation programs have enrollment limits and registration deadlines. To ensure a spot in your favorite activity, please be sure to register before the registration deadline. Registering early allows staff to prepare and gather supplies. If space is still available in a program after the registration deadline, late fees may apply.



Group Swim Lesson Levels

Group lessons are offered for all ability levels, making it as convenient as possible for families with children of all ages. All instructors are certified through an instructor course. Eight lessons are scheduled per session.

Parent and Child

AGES: 6 MONTHS - 2 YEARS | 30 MIN, DEPTH: 4.5 FT

Children will develop a comfort level in and around the water. It will provide the parent with the necessary knowledge and skills to orient the child to the water and safely supervise water activities. One adult must accompany the child in the water.

Preschool

AGES: 3 - 4 YEARS | 30 MIN, DEPTH: VARIES

Children gain greater independence in their skills and develop more comfort in and around the water. Swimmers will put their faces under water.

Learn To Swim (LTS)

AGES: 5+ YEARS | 30 MIN, DEPTH: VARIES

Level 1: Introduction to Water Skills is for a first-time swimmer. Enter and exit water safely. Practice putting face in water and blowing bubbles through mouth and nose. Front and back glide, back float. Explore arm and hand movements.

Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills Fully submerge and hold breath. Float on front and back. Roll over from front to back, back to front. Glide on front and back. Tread water. Combine arm and leg actions on back and front.

Level 3: Stroke Development Enter water by jumping from side. Rotary breathing. Change from vertical to horizontal position on front and back. Front crawl and elementary backstroke. Flutter, dolphin and scissors kick. Head first entries from sitting/kneeling.

Level 4: Stroke Improvement Swim underwater. Front and back crawl. Elementary backstroke. Breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly. Front crawl and backstroke open turns. feet first surface dive and survival swimming.

Level 5: Stroke Refinement Front and back crawl. Elementary backstroke. Breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly. Tuck and pike surface dives. Front flip and backstroke flip turn. Rescue breathing. Shallow angle dive. Safety topics and more.

Level 6: Swimming and Skill Proficiency Fitness swimmer. Personal water safety and fundamentals of diving.

Level 7: Competitive Swimming *Pre-requisite: must be able to swim 25 yards of freestyle and backstroke.* Freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly, turns, and endurance swimming. Class is dependent on instructor availability.

- · JC Parks is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Coin operated lockers are available and recommended at each facility.
- Complimentary lifejackets available at the admission booth.
- Diaper changing stations are available in the restrooms.
- · It is the patron's responsibility to read and obey all posted signs for safety.

Facility Rules

- · Profane language is not allowed. Patrons using inappropriate language will be asked to exit the facility for the day **without** a refund.
- Children under 7 years old should be within an arm's length of parent/guardian while in the water at all times.
- All patrons must pay to enter whether swimming or observing.
- Pool patrons are allowed to leave and re-enter the pools and must have a wrist-band for re-entry.
- Patrons wearing street clothes will not be allowed admission into facility unless as a guardian of a child 10 years or younger.
- Appropriate swim attire must be worn, including male swim trunks, female one or two piece suits and tankinis. Suits should not be see through. No thongs, pants, jean shorts or shorts with belt loops or rivets, inappropriate language, and anything else deemed not appropriate by pool staff.
- Children 12 years and under MUST be accompanied and ٠ supervised by a person 15 years of age or older.
- · Outside food, drink, coolers or glass containers are not allowed into the pools.
- JC Parks reserves the right to check baggage if necessary.
- · Persons must be able to swim on their own to use waterslides.
- Paging patrons is not permitted.
- · No smoking/vaping in the pool complex or parking lot.
- Any person suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted into the facility.
- · Water wings/small inner tubes are permitted if parent/guardian is within reach of the child. NO Rafts/large inner tubes. Noodles are allowed into the facility.
- · Footballs/basketballs are not allowed.
- · Close fitting swim diapers are required for those not potty trained. Swim diapers are available for purchase.
- If you, your child, or anyone in your family has had diarrhea in the past two weeks, please do not use the pool.
- · Lifeguards and managers have final authority.

Clear Bag Policy

JC Parks has a clear bag policy at Memorial Park Family Aquatic Center and Ellis-Porter Riverside Pool during public session hours.

This policy supports our priority to create a fun and safe environment for our pool guests and staff.

Each patron may bring one clear bag of any size. Mesh bags are also acceptable.

In addition to a clear/mesh bag, patrons may bring in a small clutch that does not exceed 4.5" x 6.5".

Q. Will I be able to purchase a clear bag at the pool?






Private Lessons

JC Parks is just outside your door with facilities that are ready for you to enjoy! Public parks, trails, and facilities are open year-round from 5:00 AM to 10:00 PM, unless otherwise noted on park signage or here in the program guide (neighborhood parks, for example, close at sunset).

Our department maintains:

- 20 parks that cover 1,400 acres of parkland
- 40 miles of trails
- 17 ball fields
- 14 playgrounds
- 8 pickleball courts
- 2 swimming pools
- 2 disc golf courses
- 1 public golf course

- 1 outdoor amphitheater

Dog Park

Permit Required Fees: \$48 / Annual Access

Located in North Jefferson Recreation Area, this 2-acre dog park offers a safe, fenced, off-leash area for dogs to stretch their legs and exercise.

The park includes a double-gated entrance, water source, waste disposal stations, and park benches throughout the site. Rules, regulations, and use guidelines are posted on-site to help dogs and their owners feel comfortable and welcome.

Annual permits can be purchased at the Linc (1299 Lafayette Street) during regular hours.

Launch Your Boat

Grab your poles and paddles, we've got four places to launch your boat and enjoy time on the water:

Binder Lake Boat Ramp: Binder Lake boat ramp sports "rougher" texture that eliminates slipping on the moss during the summer. The ramp is at a greater pitch which makes loading and unloading much easier.

Missouri River Access: The river has always been right in our backyard. Now it is easily accessible! Wilson's Serenity Point at Carl R. Noren Missouri River Access, located in North Jefferson Recreation Area, is open from 5:00 AM to 10:00 PM.

Hough Park Lake: boating (hand-launched) and bank fishing are permitted at Hough Park Lake. Access to the golf course irrigation lake is at the end of Iven Road. For personal safety, fishing and boating are not allowed near hole #3 on the north end of lake.

McKay Park Lake: In addition to bank fishing, handlaunched boating is now permitted at McKay Park Lake. Bring your favorite non-motorized water vessel during park hours of 5:00 AM to 10:00 PM. All vehicles and trailers must remain in designated parking lots and roadways as they are not permitted on trails or grass areas.



Outdoor Archery Range

The Archery Range at Binder Park, near the entrance to the campgoround, was completed in December of 2024. Built with support from the Missouri Department of Conservation's Outdoor Infrastructure Grant, the range includes four shooting lanes with targets and protective backdrops, bow and quiver holders, and lines delineating target distances.

RECYCLING BASICS

Recycling is easy with single-stream collection using your gray-top can! Just toss approved items into one container:

- Metals: Aluminum and tin cans, trays, foils, and empty aerosol cans.
- **Paper:** Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, and tearable paper.
- Cardboard: Pizza, gift, cereal, and cake boxes (no food residue).
- Plastics: Only #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, and #7 containers.
- Rinse Items: Remove food residue before recycling.
- No Plastic Bags or Glass: Keep these out of your bin.
- No Styrofoam: Foam cups, plates, and utensils aren't accepted.
- Avoid Hazardous Waste: No motor oil or chemicals.
- Keep It Clean & Recycle Right: Contaminated items disrupt the process.When in doubt, stick to the basics!

GLASS RECYCLING

Glass food and beverage containers of any color are accepted at drop-off locations. No need to sort or remove labels just place lids back on. Items like Pyrex, ceramics, window glass, toilets, and TVs are not accepted.



For reusable items, consider donating them to Habitat for Humanity.

Where does the glass go?

Glass to be recycled is consolidated at a city facility and then sent via tractor trailer to Ripple Glass in Kansas City, MO. Upon arriving at Ripple, glass is cleaned, sorted and crushed into cullet. The cleaned cullet is then made into insulation or new glass bottles.
