Joseph C. Miller Park RC Flying Field | JC Parks Flying Field Permit Application

All flying must be done in compliance with the posted rules and other safety regulations as defined herein. The official AMA Safety Code and all safety rules contained in the AMA Official Model Aircraft Regulations shall apply to all activities at the field. In situations where specific guidance is not provided, sound judgment must prevail.

- 1. Individual flying permits are required. Applications for individual flying permits may be obtained from JCP.
- 2. Fliers must have their JCP permit in their possession when flying at the field and must display their permit to JCP staff, JCRC members and law enforcement officers upon request.
- 3. A current AMA membership is required for issuance of a JCP permit for flying at Miller Flying Field.
- 4. In addition to AMA membership, users of the flying field must abide by all applicable federal, state and local regulations.
- 5. All users of the flying field agree to abide by the provisions of the AMA Aeronautics National Model Aircraft Safety Code, which is posted in the pavilion at the flying field.
- 6. The flying field is open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., but gas and nitro engines may only be operated from 9:00 a.m. to sunset.
- 7. Upon arrival, all pilots must record their presence at the flying field by entering requested data in the logbook each time they utilize the flying field. The logbook is located in the pavilion.
- 8. All flying shall be confined to the air space designated on the aerial map displayed in the pavilion. No flying over the spectator, parking or pit areas is permitted within that air space.
- 9. At no time shall any person fly an aircraft in such a manner that it passes over an occupied dwelling. Flying over dwellings is grounds for suspension of flying privileges at the field, & repeated violations will result in termination of such privileges.
- 10. Absolutely no flying allowed beyond the eastern tree line bordering Heritage Hollows subdivision.
- 11. Except for the case of hand-launched aircraft, pilots must be on the flight line when flying any aircraft. The flight line is a strip of grass and asphalt surface, 25 feet wide, abutting the side of the paved runway nearest to Rainbow Drive and extending away from the paved runway, parallel to the paved runway, for its entire length. Other than pilots, only spotters are permitted on the flight line while aircraft are being flown.
- 12. Hand launching aircraft must be done from the flight line or from the grass area on the northeast end of the field. Pilots who hand launch aircraft must remain in the area where the launch occurred while flying the aircraft.
- 13. The pit area extends from the northern edge of the flight line to the gravel road. It is to be used for flight prep activities.
- 14. Spectators are allowed only in the parking area, bleachers and pavilion. However, spectators may be taken to other areas of the flying field if closely supervised by a permit holder.
- 15. When a model experiences radio interference or dead stick, the pilot or his helper shall loudly and clearly warn other flyers of the situation. Landing priority shall be given immediately to the flyer experiencing difficulty.
- 16. Any transmitter frequencies used at the flying field for radio-controlled operations shall be authorized for that purpose by the Federal Communications Commission.
- 17. Sailplane high starts will run parallel with the active runway & the line will be equipped with a drag chute or similar device.
- 18. Mufflers are required for all engines over 0.051 cubic inches.
- 19. No engine or motor running is allowed in the spectator area.
- 20. All trash must be placed in the trash containers at the flying field.
- 21. Automobiles must be parked on the north side of the gravel road. The gate shall be locked when the field is not in use.
- 22. No one is allowed in the barn area without written permission from JCP.
- 23. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the premises.
